MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF BIG BEAR MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT HELD ON THURSDAY, JULY 5, 2012

CALL TO ORDER

President Eminger called the Open Session to order at 1:00 PM. Those in attendance included Director Murphy, Director Suhay, Director Smith, District Counsel Wayne Lemieux (via Skype), General Manager Scott Heule, and Board Secretary Vicki Sheppard.

REPORTS

General Manager, Scott Heule reported that we are already nearly half way through the summer. He added that ramp attendants now are almost routinely catching Quagga Mussel infested boats attempting to launch. He explained that one boater spent over \$1,200 at a marine repair shop to get his boat cleaned to the point of being able to visit our lake. He commented that District staff spent a couple hours decontaminating an infested pontoon boat that we had quarantined. He explained that he feels we should establish a fee for this kind of work so we can recoup our expense. Mr. Heule reported on the disappointing results for the Carp Roundup. He explained that the windy weather reduced visibility and sent the carp down. He added that only about 4100 pounds were recovered. He stated that our electro-shock boat will be going out on the water as soon as the last of the herbicide is administered. He reported that last month we fell below our required fish release flow rate at Station A for several days. He explained that even though the rate at Station B met target requirements, downstream plant transpiration decreased Station A flows below the 1.2 cfs standard. He commented that fish releases have been increased and will be reviewed again later this month when the data is downloaded from the recording device at Station A. Mr. Heule updated everyone on last night (the 4th of July) commenting that it was fairly uneventful except for a minor confrontation where a boater shoved ramp attendant Chris Jackson. He explained that the sheriffs came and spoke to the boater (on 2 separate occasions) adding that no punches were thrown and no one was hurt. He reported on another incident where two inflatables were in the middle of the lake with 4 persons in each boat well after dark. He explained that neither of the boats had any lights so lake patrol couldn't see them and might have run into them. He added that they were removed from the lake.

APPROVAL OF CONSENT CALENDAR

Upon a motion by Director Suhay, seconded by Director Murphy, the following consent items were unanimously approved:

CONSIDER APPROVAL OF IN-LIEU WATER MOU BETWEEN BBMWD AND SAN BERNARDINO VALLEY MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT (VALLEY DISTRICT)

Mr. Heule reported that the Watermaster Committee reviewed the latest version of an MOU prepared by Don Evenson. He commented that the Committee would like to

continue discussions with Valley District regarding an amendment to the 1996 in-lieu agreement that would allow the District to keep water in the Lake all summer long and have Valley District deliver in-lieu of releases during the summer boating season even when the Lake level would normally require Lake releases. He explained that Valley District would be "paid back" the water they delivered during this time with releases made after the Labor Day weekend. He reported that Don Evenson has suggested that additional operational efficiencies could be made that would provide for emergency storage of water in the Lake for Valley District but the details and modeling to understand the full impact of the storage has not been completed.

Mr. Heule reported that Valley District is undertaking a construction project that might interfere with their ability to deliver water to some of their customers during 2013. He added that they would like to enter into an MOU, which term would extend from July 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013, to store water in Big Bear Lake by making in-lieu deliveries to Bear Valley Mutual when Lake releases would normally be made under the Lake Release Policy and to use the stored water, as needed, to meet its water delivery needs while the elements of their delivery system are out of service. Mr. Heule explained that by making in-lieu deliveries to Bear Valley Mutual when Lake releases would normally be made, Valley District would create a storage account in the Lake that could be used as needed during construction. He added that the water that is left in the Lake after the term of the MOU would either be incorporated into an amendment to the in-lieu agreement if all parties can agree or will no longer be callable by Valley District. He reported that the Committee would like to continue moving forward on a possible amendment to the 1996 in-lieu agreement and believes the proposed June 2012 MOU is a good step towards accomplishing the longer term goal. He explained that the Watermaster Committee is recommending approval of the proposed MOU. Mr. Heule reported that on Tuesday the Valley District Board approved the MOU. To Begin the process of amending the 1996 In-Lieu Agreement, Big Bear and Valley District are willing to enter into this July 2012 MOU to replicate the conditions under Amendment 1 of the June 1999 Memorandum and to accommodate Valley District's needs as described in Paragraph 6 while the technical details of a future amendment to the 1996 In-Lieu Agreement are developed. This 2012 MOU will provide the Parties an opportunity to collect basic data on the effect of lake operations on Santa Ana River flows, to experiment with the impact lake releases will have on the ability of Valley District to divert lake releases for beneficial uses, and to evaluate how to maximize the effectiveness of lake releases on environmental management of Big Bear Lake and the Santa Ana River. This MOU will expire on Dec. 31, 2013 or the date the amendment to the In-Lieu Agreement is signed, whichever date occurs first.).

Director Murphy moved approval of the 2012 In-Lieu Water MOU between BBMWD and San Bernardino Valley Municipal Water District. Director Suhay seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

CONSIDER APPROVAL OF A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF BIG BEAR MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT REVISING BOUNDARIES FOR DISTRICT DIVISIONS

Mr. Heule reported that at the Board meeting of April 5, 2012, a map that delineates the new Division boundaries was approved. He added that after that Board action, Staff authorized Hicks and Hartwick Engineers to prepare the legal description that fully defines the new Divisions. He added that Hicks and Hartwick has completed their work and Board approval of the resolution will formally adopt the new boundaries. He explained that once

the resolution has been approved it will be submitted to the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters for use beginning with the November elections.

Director Smith moved approval of a Resolution revising boundaries for District Divisions. Director Murphy seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

PUBLIC FORUM

Mrs. Ellen Williams, Valley Resident, asked how many boats were on the lake for the 4th of July fireworks. Mr. Heule reported that there were several hundred; possibly 400 to 500. Mr. Jack Williams commented on speeding boats after sundown saying he shines a spot light on them and they seem to slow down.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

No announcements were made.

DIRECTOR COMMENTS

Director Suhay thanked staff for a good job on the 4th. He commented that patrol really did their job. Director Murphy asked about a lodge in the Boulder Bay area that appears to have kayaks with permits loosely stapled to their sides. He commented that this would allow for interchanging the permits between numerous kayaks. Mr. Heule said he would have staff look into it. Director Murphy also reported that he saw a contractor climbing over the fence at the dam commenting that we may want to look into other fencing and security. He also mentioned that he heard reports that both of the SS Reliefs were closed on the holiday. Mr. Heule stated that he was not aware of that and believed both were open. President Eminger commented that everyone should keep Director Fashempour in their prayers during her illness.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 1:30 P.M.

SUBJECT:

CONSIDER PROCESS FOR FILLING UNEXPIRED TERM FOR DIVISION 2 DIRECTOR VACANCY

RECOMMENDATION:

The Administrative committee will bring a recommendation to this meeting suggesting how the Board can proceed in filling this vacancy.

DISCUSSION/FINDINGS:

Due to the sad loss of Director Paula Fashempour, the Division 2 seat on the Board of Directors is vacant. The Board has a 60 day timeframe to take action on a replacement (see attached Code section). Because the last day to add a Director election to the November 6, 2012 ballot was June 29, 2012 and the Board was informed of the loss on July 9 the seat cannot be on the November 6th ballot. The Board can either call an election for the next established election or they can appoint a replacement to complete Director Fashempour's unexpired term, which runs through calendar year 2014. If the Board appoints, the person must reside within the boundaries of the most recent Division 2 boundary (see attached map). An outline of the process is described below.

Board Vacancy

- 1. District was notified of Paula's death on Monday July 9, 2012.
- 2. Last day to notify County elections official to place another office on the ballot was June 29, 2012. The position cannot be placed on the November 2012 ballot.
- 3. Board can appoint a replacement to fill the balance of the term of Paula's office, which runs through 2014.
- 4. The appointee must be an elector within the most recent Division 2 boundary.
- 5. The District must notify the County Elections Official of the vacancy within 15 days of the date the District was notified.
- 6. The Board has until Friday September 7, 2012 (60 days) to appoint a replacement or call a special election for the next established election date, which is on August 27, 2013 for a mail in ballot or November 5, 2013 for a regular election.
- 7. The Board must place a notice in three conspicuous places that a vacancy on the Board will be filled at least 15 days prior to taking action.
- 8. After an appointment is made the District has 15 days to notify the County Elections Official that an appointment has been made.
- 9. An appointee cannot use the word "incumbent" in any voter information material until he/she wins an election for the position.

The Administrative committee will be bringing a recommendation suggesting how the Board can proceed in filling the vacancy. The General Manager suggests the Board discuss an approach that begins with soliciting letters of interest from electors within Division 2 to either complete

Director Fashempour's term of office or until the next established election date. The letters of interest could include;

- 1. Name and physical address
- 2. Summary of their occupational background
- 3. Description of their Big Bear history; that is when they moved to Big Bear, what activities they are or have been involved in, any volunteer work etc.
- 4. What particular interests they have concerning the work the MWD is responsible for
- 5. Why they would like to become a Director on the MWD Board

Government Code 1780 Special District Vacancy

- 1780. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a vacancy in any elective office on the governing board of a special district, other than those specified in Section 1781, shall be filled pursuant to this section.
- (b) The district shall notify the county elections official of the vacancy no later than 15 days after either the date on which the district board is notified of the vacancy or the effective date of the vacancy, whichever is later.
- (c) The remaining members of the district board may fill the vacancy either by appointment pursuant to subdivision (d) or by calling an election pursuant to subdivision (e).
- (d) (1) The remaining members of the district board shall make the appointment pursuant to this subdivision within 60 days after either the date on which the district board is notified of the vacancy or the effective date of the vacancy, whichever is later. The district shall post a notice of the vacancy in three or more conspicuous places in the district at least 15 days before the district board makes the appointment. The district shall notify the county elections official of the appointment no later than 15 days after the appointment.
- (2) If the vacancy occurs in the first half of a term of office and at least 130 days prior to the next general district election, the person appointed to fill the vacancy shall hold office until the next general district election that is scheduled 130 or more days after the date the district board is notified of the vacancy, and thereafter until the person who is elected at that election to fill the vacancy has been qualified. The person elected to fill the vacancy shall hold office for the unexpired balance of the term of office.
- (3) If the vacancy occurs in the first half of a term of office, but less than 130 days prior to the next general district election, or if the vacancy occurs in the second half of a term of office, the person appointed to fill the vacancy shall fill the balance of the unexpired term of office.
- (e) (1) In lieu of making an appointment the remaining members of the board may within 60 days of the date the district board is notified of the vacancy or the effective date of the vacancy, whichever is later, call an election to fill the vacancy.
- (2) The election called pursuant to this subdivision shall be held on the next established election date provided in Chapter 1 (commencing with Section 1000) of Division 1 of the Elections Code that is 130 or more days after the date the district board calls the election.
- (f) (1) If the vacancy is not filled by the district board by appointment, or if the district board has not called for an election within 60 days of the date the district board is notified of the vacancy or the effective date of the vacancy, whichever is later, then the city council of the city in which the district is wholly located, or if the district is not wholly located within a city, the board of supervisors of the county representing the larger portion of the district area in which the election to fill the vacancy will be held, may appoint a person to fill the vacancy within 90 days of the date the district board is notified of the vacancy or the effective date of the vacancy, whichever is later, or the city council or board of supervisors may order the district to call an election to fill

the vacancy.

- (2) The election called pursuant to this subdivision shall be held on the next established election date provided in Chapter 1 (commencing with Section 1000) of Division 1 of the Elections Code that is 130 or more days after the date the city council or board of supervisors calls the election.
- (g) (1) If within 90 days of the date the district board is notified of the vacancy or the effective date of the vacancy, whichever is later, the remaining members of the district board or the appropriate board of supervisors or city council have not filled the vacancy and no election has been called for, then the district board shall call an election to fill the vacancy.
- (2) The election called pursuant to this subdivision shall be held on the next established election date provided in Chapter 1 (commencing with Section 1000) of Division 1 of the Elections Code that is 130 or more days after the date the district board calls the election.
- (h) (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, if the number of remaining members of the district board falls below a quorum, then at the request of the district secretary or a remaining member of the district board, the appropriate board of supervisors or the city council shall promptly appoint a person to fill the vacancy, or may call an election to fill the vacancy.
- (2) The board of supervisors or the city council shall only fill enough vacancies by appointment or by election to provide the district board with a quorum.
- (3) If the vacancy occurs in the first half of a term of office and at least 130 days prior to the next general district election, the person appointed to fill the vacancy shall hold the office until the next general district election that is scheduled 130 or more days after the date the district board is notified of the vacancy, and thereafter until the person who is elected at that election to fill the vacancy has been qualified. The person elected to fill the vacancy shall hold office for the unexpired balance of the term of office.
- (4) If the vacancy occurs in the first half of a term of office, but less than 130 days prior to the next general district election, or if the vacancy occurs in the second half of a term of office, the person appointed to fill the vacancy shall fill the balance of the unexpired term of office.
- (5) The election called pursuant to this subdivision shall be held on the next established election date provided in Chapter 1 (commencing with Section 1000) of Division 1 of the Elections Code that is held 130 or more days after the date the city council or board of supervisors calls the election.
