

Boat Permit Required for All Boats on Big Bear Lake

Permit Fees for Year 2014

REGISTERED VESSELS

Motorized boats and sailboats over 8 feet in length
Power boats, jet skis, personal water craft

Seasonal Permit

Daily Permit Rates

| One Day | \$25. ⁰⁰ | + \$10. ⁰⁰ | = \$35.⁰⁰ |
| Two Day | \$45. ⁰⁰ | + \$10. ⁰⁰ | = \$55.⁰⁰ |
| Three Day | \$65. ⁰⁰ | + \$10. ⁰⁰ | = \$75.⁰⁰ |
| Four Day | \$85. ⁰⁰ | + \$10. ⁰⁰ | = \$95.⁰⁰ |
| Five Day | \$105. ⁰⁰ | + \$10. ⁰⁰ | = \$115.⁰⁰ |

Consecutive days must be purchased during single transaction.

NON-REGISTERED VESSELS

Non-motorized boats and sailboats 8 feet or less in length
Kayaks, canoes, sailboards, stand-up paddleboards, fishing float tubes

| Three Day | | \$35. ⁰⁰ | + \$ 5. ⁰⁰ | = \$40.⁰⁰ |
| | FISHING FLOAT TUBE | | | |
| One Day | | \$12. ⁰⁰ | + \$ 3. ⁰⁰ | = \$15.⁰⁰ |
| Two Day | | \$22. ⁰⁰ | + \$ 3. ⁰⁰ | = \$25.⁰⁰ |
| Three Day | | \$32. ⁰⁰ | + \$ 3. ⁰⁰ | = \$35.⁰⁰ |

Consecutive days must be purchased during single transaction.

Permit must be displayed on boat and is non-transferable.
All boats must have current state registration.

Permits are available at most marinas, the MWD office, and public launch ramps
Boat Permits may be revoked for violation of any law.

All boats must be inspected prior to entry into Big Bear Lake.
A surcharge of \$10 will be assessed for the purchase of a permit from a Lake Patrol Officer while on the water.
